Frequently Asked Questions

HOW MUCH DOES THE PROGRAMME COST?

The programme costs £1,200 plus VAT (£800 for the course itself and £400 for access to mental health training for your colleagues), but as our training has been approved as meeting all DfE quality criteria, state funded schools in England can reclaim the full cost.

HOW DO I RECLAIM THE COURSE FEE?

Once you've booked you only need to complete a simple form. As funded places are limited, if you find out there are no grants available you can cancel any time up to the start date. If you're not eligible you can still take part, you simply won't be able to reclaim the cost. If you're in any doubt as to whether you're eligible give us a call on 020 8680 4077.

WHAT PHASES DOES THE PROGRAMME COVER?

Our programme has been accredited according to the DfE quality criteria for all phases, and we have specific modules available for colleagues from primary, secondary, post-16, special and alternative provision.
